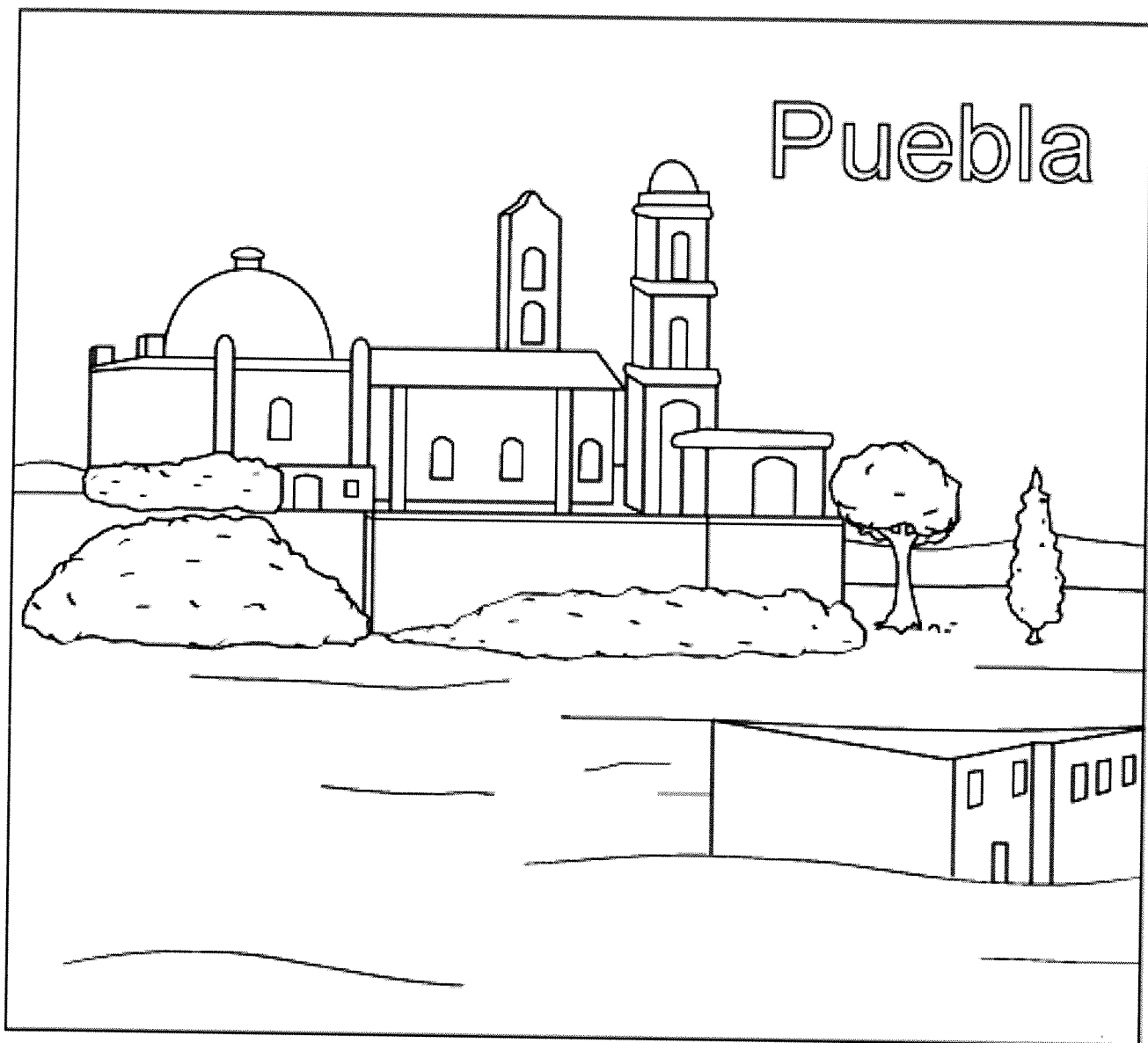


# Cinco de Mayo

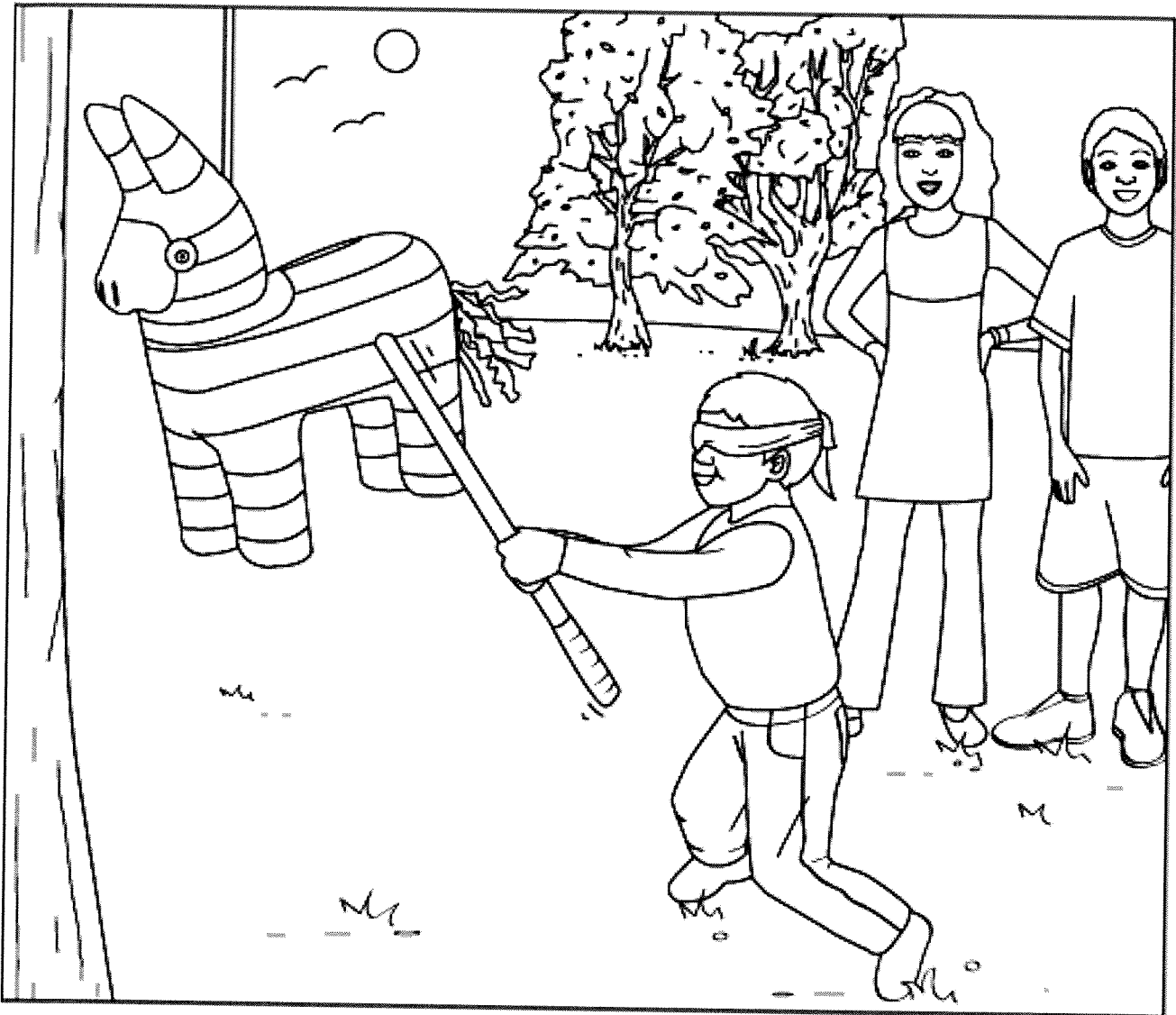


There are fireworks and fiestas, arts, crafts, and
