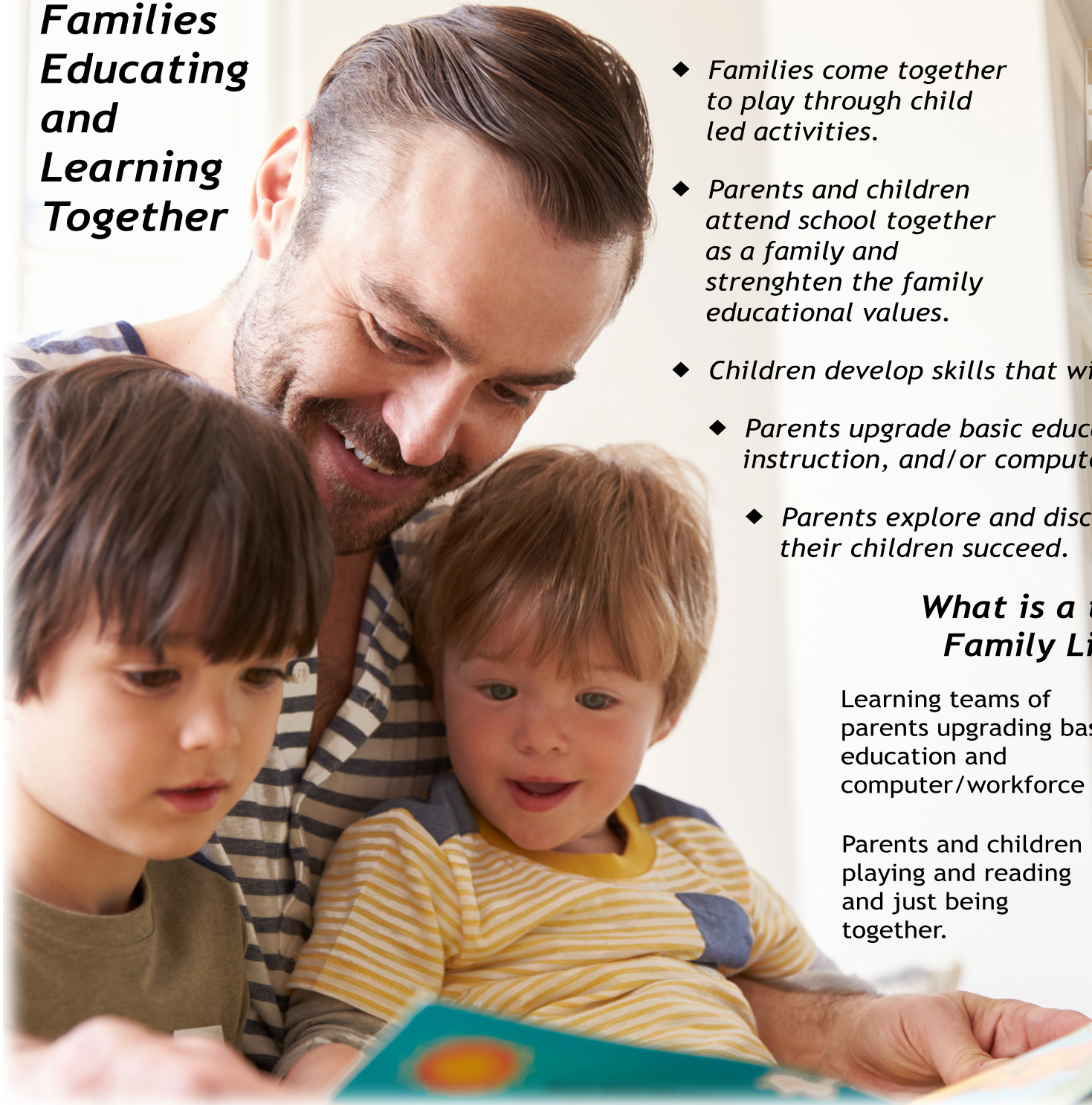


Families Educating and Learning Together
