About Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA)

- SCA is the #1 killer of student athletes.
- Every three days, a student dies from SCA.
- Some warning symptoms of SCA include dizziness, fainting, shortness of breath or chest pain.
- The first symptom of SCA is often sudden death.
- One out of every 100 students screened is found to have a previously undetected heart condition.



The Peyton Walker Foundation was established in honor of Peyton Walker, a sophomore at King's College who passed away unexpectedly from sudden cardiac arrest at age 19. The Foundation is offering this routine heart screening at no cost for students as a means of early detection for heart-related issues.
