Student Assistance Program

WHO?

Pennsylvania's SAP is a school-wide resource for students and families, who are experiencing barriers to learning because of a variety of reasons which may cause concern.

WHY?

Some reasons why students are referred are (but not limited to):

- *Withdrawing* from family, friends, and/or school
- No longer spending time with old friends; *changing friends*.
- Unexplained physical *injuries*
- Talking about *suicide*
- Depression, Aggression, Lying, Low self-esteem, Destructive decisions, Decreased motivation
- Defying authority (home or school)
- Experimenting/ possible *addiction* with drugs and/or alcohol
- Sudden *drop in grades* or Sudden *change in behavior*
- Reluctant school attendance; poor attendance
- Reaction to recent death/divorce/relationship problem
- Trouble transitioning to a new school or home

HOW?
