**Preparing for Testing**—Note test dates on your home calendar; schedule appointments on non testing days.



#### **Testing Day**

- See that your child is rested and eats breakfast.
- See that your child arrives at school on time and is relaxed.
- Encourage your child to do the best work possible.
- Remind your child to listen carefully to all directions and to ask questions about unclear instructions.

#### Parent Strategies for Reducing Test Anxiety

- Discuss the test openly and in a positive way.
- Have realistic expectations of your child's performance while encouraging his/her best efforts.
- Emphasize as long as they did their best and tried their hardest, you are proud of them!
