Seniors who have purchased a cap and gown, and have met all of the district's graduation requirement will receive a call from their principal to schedule a time to be recorded.

Recordings will be completed **BEFORE** June 5.

GUIDELINES:

- Arrive at respective buildings wearing cap and gown.
- Each graduate is permitted TWO guests.
- Social distancing must be practiced.
- Masks must be worn

PROCEDURES:

- Graduates will be recorded walking across the graduation stage to receive their diploma cover.
- After receiving their diploma cover, graduates will have their picture taken with their TWO guest.
- After pictures are taken, the graduate and their guests will exit the building, so the next graduate may enter the building.

REMINDERS:

- Arrive on time for recordings.
- If you arrive late, you will be required to wait until all scheduled appointments for that day are completed. Or, you may be asked to return on a different day.

- School belongings may NOT be collected during: Graduation Video taping Cap and Gown Distribution
