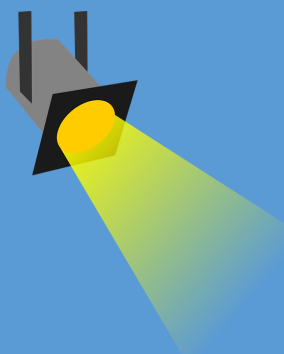
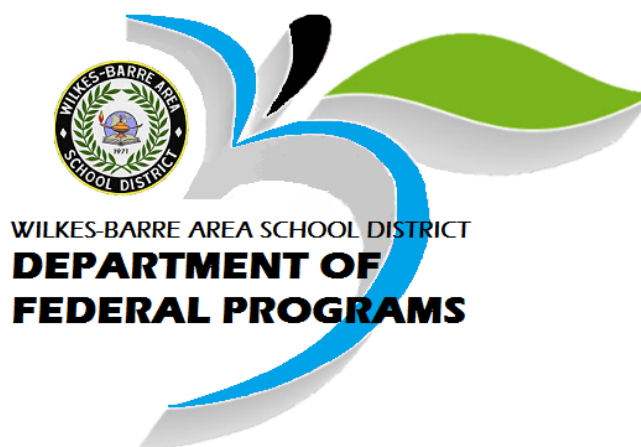

Title I Program at Solomon-Plains Elementary School Holds 3rd, 4th, and 5th Grade STEM Nights

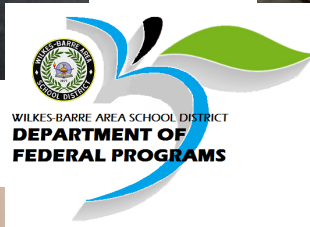

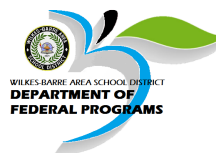
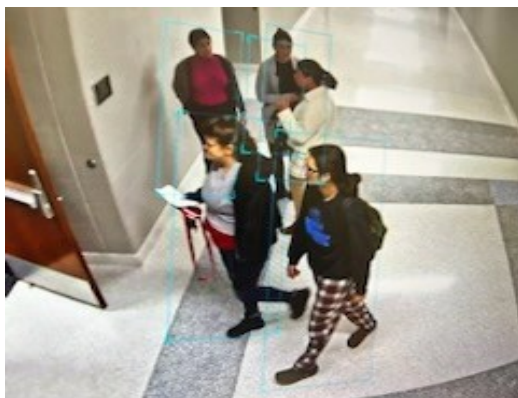
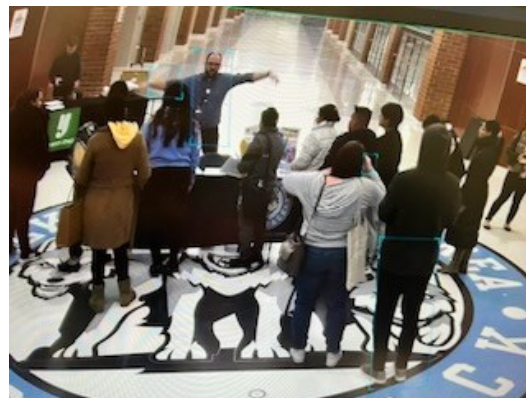
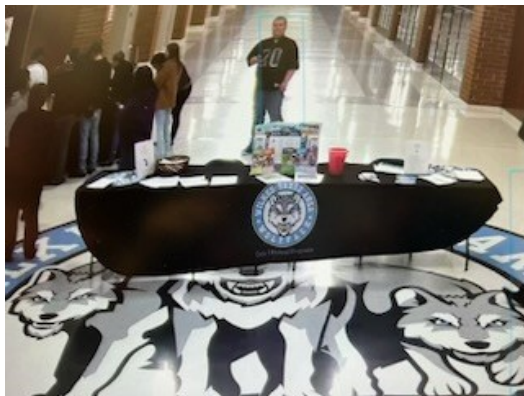


Wilkes-Barre Area High School Holds Parent & Family Engagement Event!
