Mandatory Attendance

- Punctual Attendance is mandatory!!
- Roll will be taken during practices.
- Sit in assigned seats only.
- Homes or parents' workplaces of absentees will be called to see if there is an emergency.
- After one absence, you will not appear on stage.

- A class picture and a National Honor Society picture will be taken on **Monday**, **June 5th** at 8:45am in auditorium. This requires that you be in your seat promptly **dressed in your cap and gown**.

Dress Code

- FOR ALL PRACTICES: All seniors must adhere to W-B Area Dress Code (including seniors from Service Learning or ALC)
- MOVING UP DAY/Graduation: dress pants, dress shirt, respectful dresses or skirts, and dress shoes
- NOT PERMITTED: tee shirts, shorts, jeans, sweats

Caps and Gowns

- Use only **cool** irons to press gowns.
- Gowns usually measure about 14 inches from the floor
- Girls: Collars should be attached to the inside of the gown's neckline then turned over.
- Boys: should wear a collared shirt and tie..
- Footwear **NOT** acceptable: Sneakers or flip-flops.
- The cap should be worn **flat** on the top of the head, not tilted to the back or side.
- Messages on cap or gown are **NOT** allowed.
- Only **standard** tassel should be on cap.
- Only school distributed pins are acceptable (for example: an Honor Society pin or a music award pin is allowed)
- NO body piercings other than ears may be worn.

Tickets - \$2.00 each

- For special needs seating, see Mrs. Thoma by May 26th.
- After the Moving-Up Day ceremony, each senior will receive two free graduation tickets. (You must participate in MUD to receive tickets.)
 - The seats will be located on the side of the auditorium on which you march. These tickets will be distributed on stage <u>only</u> <u>after</u> the Moving-Up day Program.
- Two additional first-floor tickets may be bought in Room 308 on Monday, June 5th, starting 12:35pm.
- On June 6th through June 8th, balcony seats and remaining first-floor seats will go on sale on a first-come, first-served basis in Room 308 beginning at 12:35 only.
- On June 9th, any remaining tickets will be on sale in the rear of the auditorium, see Mrs. Lauer until 8:00am.
- NO GUEST WILL BE ADMITTED TO THE GRADUATION CEREMONY WITHOUT A TICKET, INCLUDING CHILDREN.
- Videotaping may be done only in the balcony.

Marching

- On Moving-Up Day and Commencement Day, seniors will line up in the gym.
- A marching list will be used for attendance.
- Learn the names of the persons who march in front of you and behind you.
- Senior class officers will lead marching line. They will march down the center aisle and proceed to their assigned seats.
- On Moving-Up Day only, senior class officers will sit in special seats in front of the first row of seniors on stage. Their regular seats on the risers will remain empty.
- On Commencement Day, seniors line up at **8:45** am.
- If you are not in line by the 8:50 am Roll Call, you will not graduate on stage.
- Remember to march in time to the music.
- We will begin precisely at 9:00 am. Therefore, parents and other guests must be seated by 8:50 am.

The outside doors will be closed at 8:50 am.

ALL late Guests will be required to sit in the balcony and will not be admitted until seniors have entered the auditorium.
