ATTENDANCE

- Practice attendance is **MANDATORY** (you must attend).
- You must be on time.
- Roll will be taken daily.
- Sit in assigned seats.
- Homes will be called if absent from practice.

DRESS

CDC and PDE mandates must be followed - Masks are REQUIRED.

- Moving Up Day, First Practice and Graduation are special occasions requiring Business attire Dress pants, dress shirt, tie, dark shoes; respectful dress/skirt (nothing too short or too revealing)
- For Practices: **All seniors** should be dressed appropriately for school. (Including ALC seniors, Cyber students...)

MHS reserves the right to remove anyone deemed inappropriately dressed.

PROCEDURE

- Adjust mask
- Seniors line up in the gym.
- You must be in line by 8:45 to participate in graduation.
- To line up properly, remember the classmate in line before and after you.
- For Moving Up Day, the speakers will proceed into the auditorium down the center aisle.
- Before starting down the aisle, look for your marching partner entering through the other door
- Begin your first step with your left foot.
- March in time to the music.
- Take your time it's your big day, don't rush!!

CAPAND GOWN

- Use a **COOL** iron to press gown.
- Collars for females **MUST** be attached to the gown **AT HOME**.
- Male's shirt collar and tie are worn inside the neck of the gown.
- Caps are worn FLAT, on the top of the head.
- Caps man NOT be altered in any way.
- Only STANDARD tassel may be worn on cap.
- Only school awarded medals may be worn on gown.

TICKETS

For **special needs seating**, see Ms. Kapuschinsky in room 306 by May 28.

Graduation tickets may be pre-ordered through the Meyers website or the Senior Class Google Classroom.

- **Only ticket holders** will be admitted to the graduation ceremony, including ALL children.
- On June 7, 4 first floor and balcony tickets may be bought in room 306 beginning at 11:30.
- On June 8 all remaining first-floor and balcony tickets will be sold, on a first come, first-served basis in room 306 beginning at 11:30.
- June 9, after participation in the Moving Up ceremony, each senior will receive 2 free tickets (located on the senior's marching side of the auditorium)
 All remaining first-floor and balcony tickets will be sold, on a first come, first-served basis in room 306 beginning at 11:30.
- On June 10 any remaining tickets will be sold in the back of the auditorium until 8:00 am, See Ms. Kapuschinsky

Videotaping is permitted in the **balcony**, ONLY.

PARKING

Some parking is available along the streets near Meyers.

FAMILY

Outside doors will close at **9:20 am. ALL** latecomers will be required to sit in the balcony, **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Latecomers will not be allowed to enter the building until the last senior has entered the auditorium.

- Strollers are NOT permitted in the auditorium
- Balloons are NOT permitted in the auditorium.
- Videotaping is permitted in the balcony ONLY.
- At the end of the ceremony, **all members** of the audience are asked to remain seated until the last senior exits the auditorium.

POST GRADUATION

Seniors will leave the auditorium and go to designated rooms to receive their diploma, report card, pictures, etc.
