



## Google Meet

Changing your class meet code. Every once in a while it may be advised to change your meet code for your live instruction.


1. Google Classroom Main Screen – Click the Gear Clog



2. Scroll down to the Meet settings under General



3. Click the down arrow next to your Meet link and select Reset




## New Features

There are many new features rolling out for Google Meet. These features give you more control of the Meet experience.


**Integration of Jamboard** – This is a virtual whiteboard. We will have more details on this with a later post.

**Enhanced Tile View** – You can now display up to 49 virtual participants.


1. Click the 3 dots bottom right of window and select Change layout



2. Use the slider bar to increase the number of participant views. **Note: This must be done each time you start meet as the settings are not saved.**



New Safety Features – Click the Shield on the bottom left



Send Chat Messages: You can stop chat messages within the Meet

Share the Screen: You can stop participants from sharing their screen

Quick Access: You can individually allow participants (Not Recommended)
