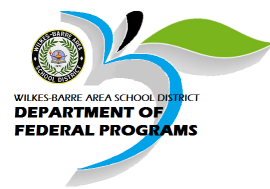
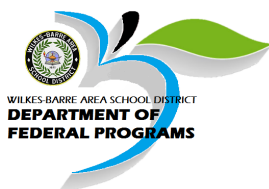




Wilkes-Barre High Area High School Holds Title I Event—Parent-Teacher Conferences

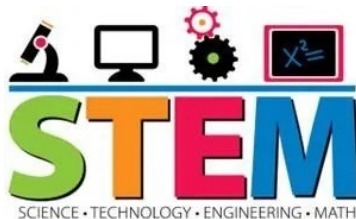


Wilkes-Barre Area High School Holds Parent & Family Engagement STEM Event!
