

Summary of Minutes  
Regular Board Meeting  
Monday, May 13, 2013

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Rev. Shawn Walker was administered the Oath of Office by Judge William Amesbury at the Committee Meeting of May 13, 2013.

Rev. Shawn Walker was nominated and selected by the Members of the Wilkes-Barre Area Board of Directors at a Special Board Meeting held on May 9, 2013 to fill the vacancy on the Board created by Dr. Robert Corcoran no longer being a Member of the Wilkes-Barre Area School District Board of Directors.

**President, John R. Quinn** called the meeting to order at 7:23 PM.

**Superintendent Dr. Bernard S. Prevuznak** led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

**Board Secretary Leonard B. Przywara** called the roll.

President Quinn stated:

#### **Treasurer's Report**

**Communication from Superintendent**

Dr. Prevuznak informed the Board that the District received notification from the Pennsylvania Department of Education, that Wilkes-Barre Area School District was awarded a "Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Grant" in the amount of \$177,204.00 to be used for the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program at Dodson, Kistler, Flood and Heights Murray Elementary schools.

**Communications from Citizens**

1. Jeff Ney, 703 Metcalf Street, Wilkes-Barre, PA 18702  
Mr. Ney stated that as President of the Wilkes-Barre Area Education Association, he would like to welcome Rev. Shawn Walker to the Wilkes-Barre Area School District School Board and noted that he (Mr. Ney) is looking forward to working with Rev. Walker along with the other members of the School Board regarding matters that affect the students of the Wilkes-Barre Area School District. Mr. Ney informed the Board that last week was "Teacher Appreciation Week" and the 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Teacher Appreciation Dinner was held. Mr. Ney informed the Board that part of the dues paid by the members of the Teachers Association contribute to the Leadership Scholarship award that is presented each year to a member of the graduating class of each Wilkes-Barre Area School District High School in the amount of \$3,500.00 to each recipient. Mr. Ney stated that this year awards were presented to: Cindy Anusiewicz, Coughlin High School, Jian (Jenny) Chi, G.A.R. High School and Brooke Yanovich, Meyers High School. Mr. Ney also noted that Kevin Sickle, a Wilkes-Barre Area School District teacher, assigned to Heights Murray Elementary School was recognized by the United Way and was presented the "Tony Kane Award", a highly prestigious award that recognizes "Labor Leadership". Mr. Ney further noted that Mr. Sickle gives of himself always which includes giving to the students in his classroom at Heights Murray Elementary. Mr. Ney also informed the Board that State Representative, Edward Pashinski was the Teachers Association "Friend In Education" this year and attended and spoke at the Teacher Appreciation Dinner.

Dr. Prevuznak, Interim Superintendent and the Members of the Board of Wilkes-Barre Area School District congratulated Kevin Sickle in regard to receiving the "Tony Kane Award" from the United Way.

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2. Angel Mathis, 149 North Main Street, Wilkes-Barre, PA 18702  
Ms. Mathis addressed the Board regarding questions and concerns regarding a citation she received in regard to her child's school attendance. Ms. Mathis informed the Board of the situation involving her daughter's absence from school and was in the process of trying to resolve the issue of the citation. Ms. Mathis informed the Board that her daughter has a condition that required home bound instruction, she (Ms. Mathis) requested home bound instruction and provided a Dr.'s note to the District indicating the need for homebound services. Ms. Mathis stated that she waited from September to December to receive home bound instruction for her daughter and was informed that once the homebound instruction began, the home bound services would not be provided until after 3:00 PM. Ms. Mathis was also informed that there were two (2) choices available to her daughter, one being , staying on homebound for an entire year or entering cyber school, Ms. Mathis stated that neither of which was going to serve her daughter's needs. Ms. Mathis decided to enroll her daughter in Commonwealth Connections Academy; however it took more than fifteen days to be enrolled due to the fact that there was not a current IEP available. Ms. Mathis wanted the Board to know the circumstances surrounding the citation she received in the hope that another student would not face the same situation.

Dr. Prevuznak informed Ms. Mathis that he would investigate the reason for the delay in home bound services being available and also the issue of the IEP not being available.

Attorney Wendolowski informed Ms. Mathis that he would address the citation and ensure that the issue was resolved.
