## Arctic Ocean Mobile - Grades 1-4

Make a mobile of animals that live in and near the Arctic Ocean.

The patterns included can also be used to make arctic scenes on construction paper.

## **Materials Needed:**

Crayons, colored pencils, scissors, glue, tape, string or yarn, hanger or dowels
Alternate: instead of dowels, large sheets of construction paper, light blue and white for the ocean and ice flows

## Directions:

- Color the various arctic animals. Use references from books or the Internet for coloration information. You will need to color each animal twice for the mobile.
- 2) Cut out the animals. Each has two matching pictures.
- 3) Fasten a string to the back of the animal with a small piece of tape and hang from a hanger or dowels. Once you have the animal hanging as you wish, glue the 2<sup>nd</sup> matching animal to the back of it. If you are hanging them from a hanger, you might need to put 2 animals on one string. (See illustration) Hang the whales and the swimming seals low, as if they are in the water, and the animals on the ice flows higher.
