

Arctic Ocean Mobile - Grades 1-4

Make a mobile of animals that live in and near the Arctic Ocean.

The patterns included can also be used to make arctic scenes on construction paper.

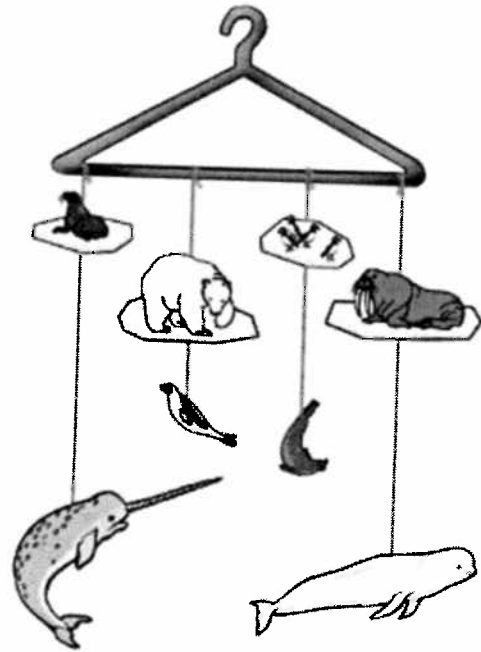
Materials Needed:

Crayons, colored pencils, scissors, glue, tape, string or yarn, hanger or dowels

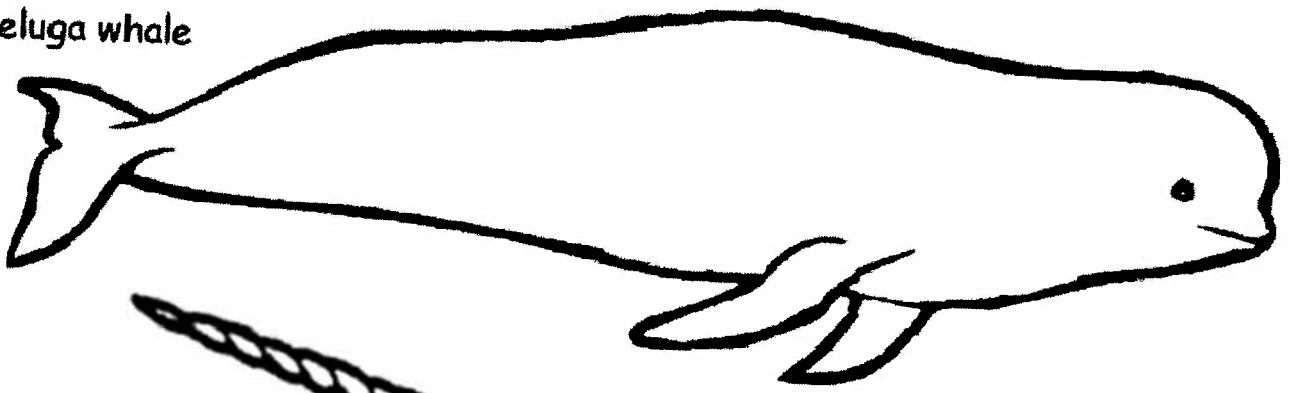
Alternate: instead of dowels, large sheets of construction paper, light blue and white for the ocean and ice flows

Directions:

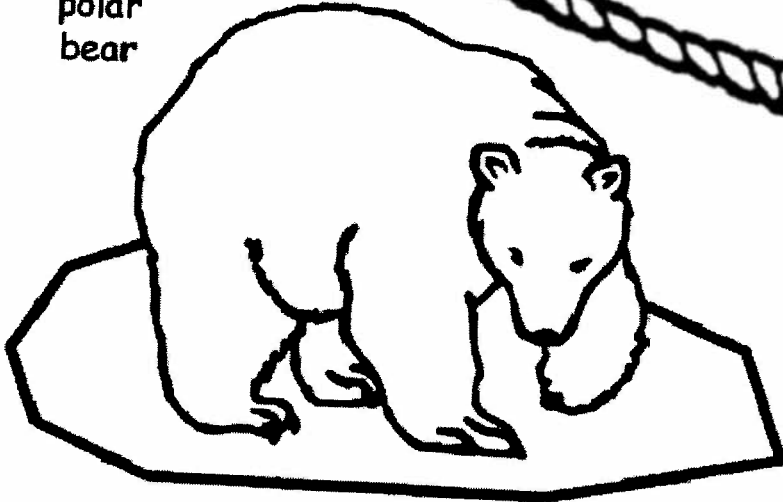
- 1) Color the various arctic animals. Use references from books or the Internet for coloration information. You will need to color each animal twice for the mobile.
- 2) Cut out the animals. Each has two matching pictures.
- 3) Fasten a string to the back of the animal with a small piece of tape and hang from a hanger or dowels. Once you have the animal hanging as you wish, glue the 2nd matching animal to the back of it. If you are hanging them from a hanger, you might need to put 2 animals on one string. (See illustration) Hang the whales and the swimming seals low, as if they are in the water, and the animals on the ice flows higher.



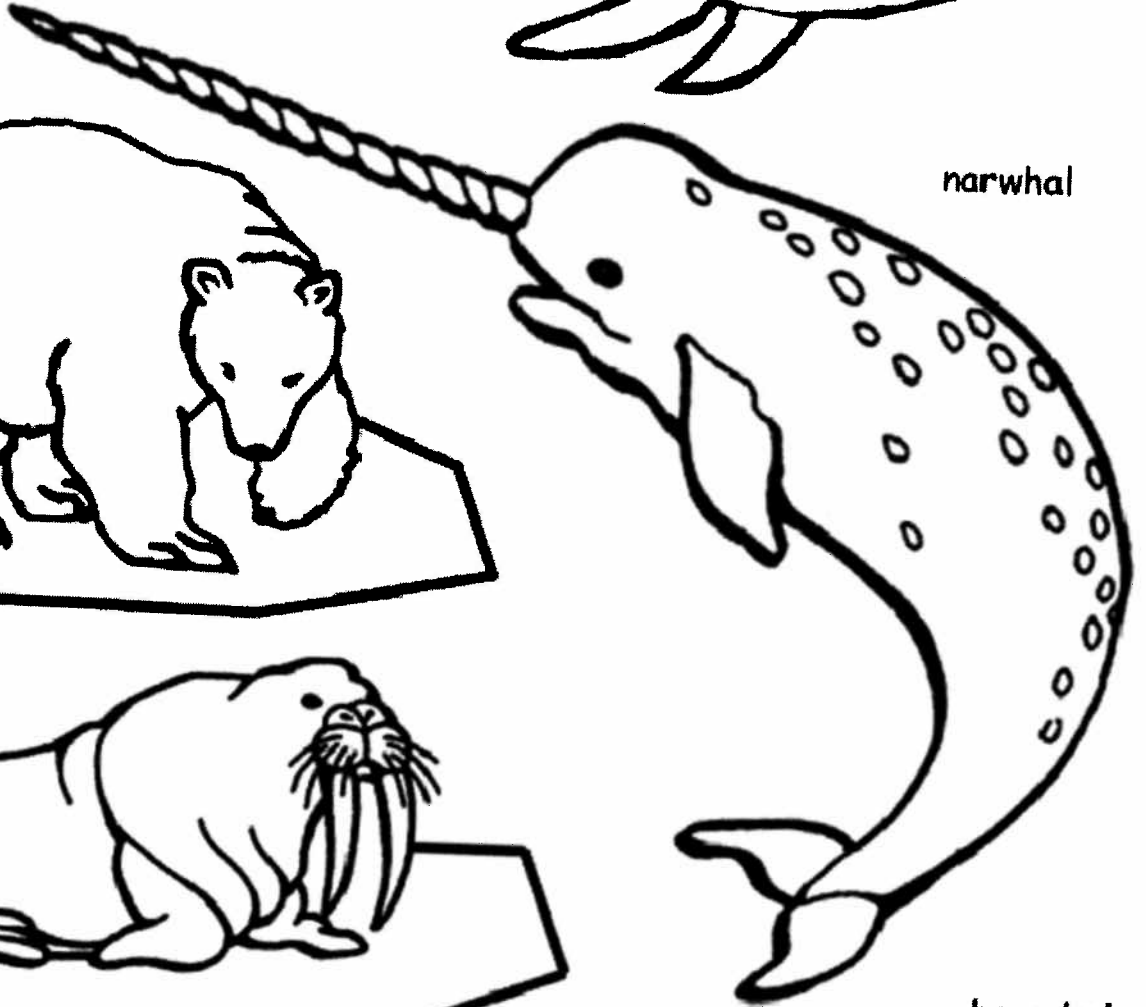

bearded seal



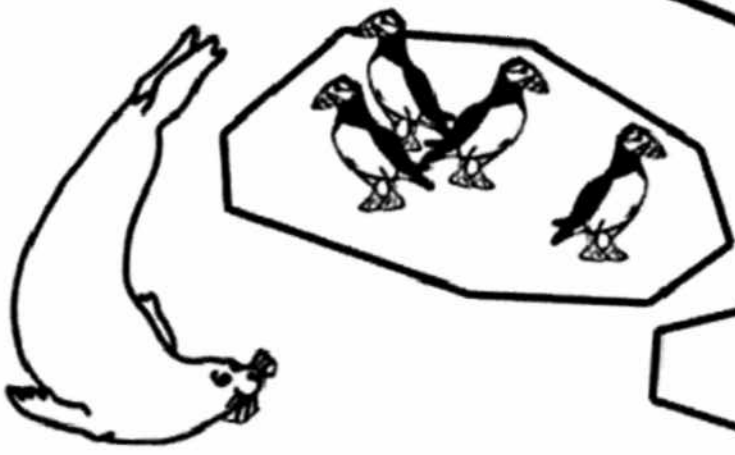
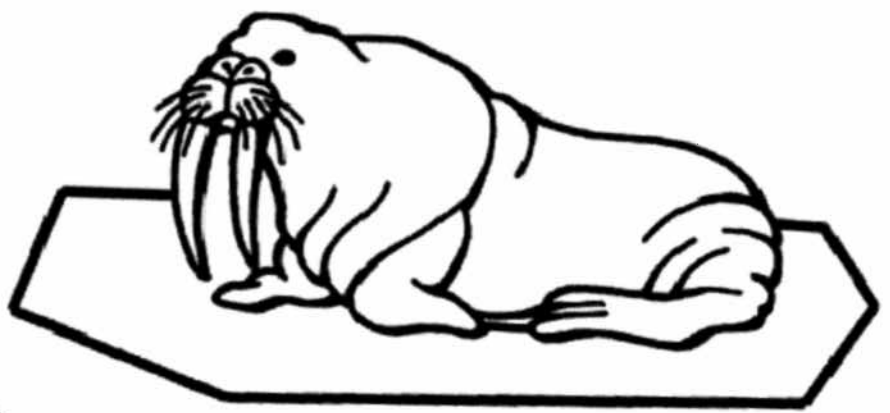
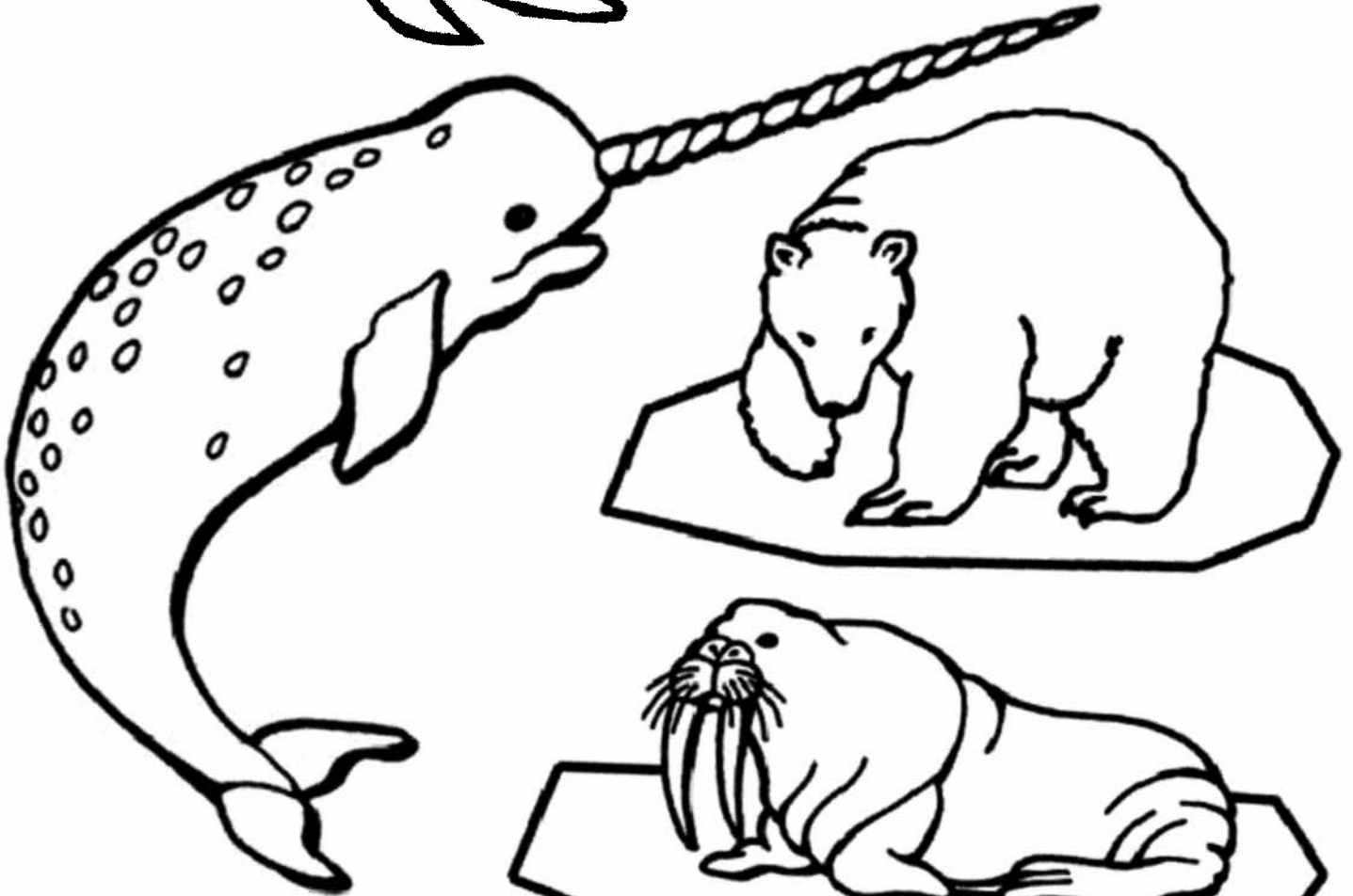
